

SIR Neighborhood Watch "Warriors" Monthly Report

May 10, 2016

On April 18, 2016, the SIR Neighborhood Watch Chairperson, Valerie Edwards and Secretary Patti Webber, were invited to attend the Quarterly Law Enforcement meeting with the SIR Tribal Chairman and Tribal Administrator. Chairperson Valerie Edwards gave a brief presentation of the SIR Neighborhood Watch Program to local law enforcement entities, which included the Susanville Police Department, Lassen County Sheriff's Department, California Highway Patrol and the Diamond Mountain Casino & Hotel's Security Department.

On April 19, 2016, Valerie Edwards met with the Security Department of the Diamond Mountain Casino & Hotel to discuss the implementation of SIR Neighborhood Watch Program.

The patrols of the SIR Neighborhood Watch are approximately 160 miles a month. The vehicle on the upper reservation patrols about 120 miles a month (3-4 nights a week). The vehicle on the lower reservation patrols about 40 miles a month. Due to the lack of drivers and the need to have two individuals in the vehicle to patrol, the usage of the vehicle on the lower reservation has been limited at this time.

A resident on Weatherlow Street at the entrance into Hammawi Court stopped the Chairperson while on patrol and thanked her for the presence of the SIR Neighborhood Watch patrols. Resident told her of suspicious activity that has occurred in that vicinity.

It needs to be noted to the that when a block captain is notified of suspicious activity, it is not the responsibility of that Block Captain to take action on the incident. If a crime is being committed, call law enforcement and notify the Chairperson and/or Block Captain of incident. The Block Captain will notified the Chairperson of incident. The purpose of the Neighborhood Watch is to observed and report any suspicious activity and the appropriate action will be addressed.

A SIR Neighborhood Watch Community Meeting will be held on Wednesday, May 11, 2016. This meeting will be a presentation by the CHP and Lassen County Sheriffs' Department on "Crime Prevention and Vehicle Theft".

Block Captains' Meetings will be held on the **1st Wednesday of each month**, and the **NW Community Meetings** will be held the **2nd Wednesday of each month**.
