Dear Chairman

In 2001, with unanimous support of the President's Native American Advisory Council, the Susanville Indian Rancheria were included in the University of Oregon's Residency by Aboriginal Right Program. All enrolled members of your nation are eligible for in-state tuition at the University of Oregon regardless of where they reside. For students who do not live in Oregon, this is a savings of approximately \$20,000 per year.

This letter reaffirms our commitment to the Susanville Indian Rancheria to allow all enrolled tribal members to attend the University of Oregon at in-state tuition rates. A copy of this letter will be placed in the Office of Admissions to serve as a reminder of our long-standing commitment to your nation.
