



Susanville Indian Rancheria Education Center (SIREC) 2017 Summer Program Applications Now Available!

Application Deadline: June 9, 2017 by 4:00pm

(Completed applications received after deadline will be put on a wait list.)

SIREC will hold a free summer program for Native youth ranging from Grades k thru 8 from **June 19, 2017 thru August 3, 2017**. Generally, the SIREC summer program hours will run from 11:00am to 3:00pm Monday thru Thursday for the 7-week time period except on field trip days.

There are **ONLY 50** participant slots available and acceptance will be on a first come first served basis. SIREC staff will contact those on the wait list only if a slot opens up for student participation.

Students enrolled in our summer program will have the opportunity to participate in fun and educational field trips focused on science and cultural activities, along with other recreational, cultural, and educational enrichment activities. Families of enrolled students are also encouraged to participate in some program activities.



Application Process:

The SIREC summer program application is available at the SIR Education Center. Completed applications should be submitted to the SIREC office by the deadline for full consideration. All information must be complete.

NOTE: This program is for Federally Recognized Native Tribal children and for children in households of Federally Recognized Native Tribal members.
