**Public Review and Comment for Nonpoint Source Pollution (NPS) Assessment
Report and Management Plan**

The Susanville Indian Rancheria (SIR) has received program eligibility status from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 9, through Sections 106 and 319 of the Clean Water Act (CWA), to develop a Tribal Water Pollution Management Program. In 2006, as part of this program, the SIR Natural Resources Department (NRD) completed a Nonpoint Pollution Source Assessment and Management Plan to help identify and address nonpoint sources of pollution and to establish baseline water quality data. This Plan is an update to the previously approved Assessment and Management plan to include newly acquired properties and to incorporate data collected through the CWA 106 program.

The NRD has posted the draft plan on the SIR website to [allow tribal members to provide comments regarding Nonpoint source pollution issues and concerns.](#)
