### Non-Recurrent Short-Term Benefits for Crisis Services due to COVID-19

Assistance is available to current CTTTP Participants and Community Members who have at least one eligible Native American child residing in the home.

**\*Current CTTTP Participants will automatically receive this benefit.**

Eligibility for Non-CTTTP Participants (Community Members) is as follows:

1. 300% Federal Poverty Limit
2. Living in a County of Crisis served by CTTTP
3. 60 Month Time Limit Excluded
4. Not receiving County Cash Assistance

Needed documents to determine eligibility: ID for Head of Household adult, Tribal Verification, residence verification (utility bill, rental agreement, etc.), income verification and copies of only one (1) native child's birth certificate.
