#### Narrative:

On 7-06-2021 at approximately 1422 C-601 and E-621 dispatched to the area of Highway 139 at mile marker 3 for a report of a wildland fire. Cal/Fire also dispatched to the incident. Battalion 6601 first unit on scene and gave a dispatch of a 50x50 spot fire. A water can was utilized to aid in extinguishing the fire. Cal/Fire E-2291 was also used to check for hot spots and put out any fire that was not extinguished by the water can. C-601 remained on scene until approximately 1614 with E-2291. E-621 cancelled by E-2291.

C-601 and C-6601 performed an investigation and determined that the fire was possible caused by a vehicle towing a trailer with a flat tire. The road had marks on it indicating a possible flat tire. The marks on the road were close to the edge of the road indicating the possible flat was on the passenger side of the vehicle.

The fire was more than likely caused by a spark that came off the flat tire that had possibly came off the rim. The fire was extinguished by E-2291. All units finished at scene and returned to quarters.
