• There were 2 incidents this period requiring law enforcement investigations.

Compliance

There are 157 Class III Gaming machines on the floor and 42 in storage –10% have been audited of the 10% NIGC MICS requirement have been audited for 2021.

Licensing

- During this period the Gaming Commission approved 2 new licenses for the casino.
- The casino currently has 131 gaming licensed employees, 27 of which are Native American – 22 of which are Tribal members.
