ITEM:	CURRENT ACTIVITY
AIEC- (Education Grant)	<p>The school year is at an end, and we have been busy providing incentives to our students enrolled in the center programs who completed their grade level with success.</p> <p>We are accepting applications to the summer program and are ready for the kids beginning June 14<sup>th</sup>. We have many fun adventures planned and are looking forward to it.</p> <p>Amy was able to participate in the Diploma Gold graduation ceremony, where 2 of our tribal members, 1 tribal family member and a prior student of the Education Center graduated.</p> <p>The 2020/2021 school year will be getting out June 11<sup>th</sup>. Summer school will start right after and run for 4 weeks. Our Summer Program will start that same day. We will be offering transportation from summer school to the center, and home at the end of the day. Summer school will be Monday through Thursday, and center will be open 5 days a week. We will be offering lots of enrichment activities, local field trips, and out of town field trips on Fridays. We have new applicants for the tutor position and will be having interviews soon.</p>
JOM	<p>In March, JOM requested a student count for the services provided for the 2020-2021 year. Our count reflected 125 students who potentially received services.</p>
CCDF (Child Care) Certificate Program	<p>CCDF has been holding several meetings over the month regarding the money being dispersed under the Biden Administration. It appears the new funding will come with a high amount of reporting on statistical data and small grants to provide to childcare facilities. CCDF has been holding meetings to help answer questions regarding the ARP funding. Childcare Providers and Families were mailed out a new informational brochure based on appropriate training topics determined by grant, and interest. If you have anyone interested in being a new provider, please let us know.</p>
IMLS (Library)	<p>We are still working on inventorying the library. The new grant for ILMs has been submitted for the grant year 2021-2022. We look forward to expanding our library resources based on higher demands for social and emotional wellbeing.</p>
Teen Center	<p>We lost Aaron to NRD, his last day was June 4<sup>th</sup>. We are currently flying the position to be filled.</p> <p>We were able to provide gifts to the graduates in collaboration with the Chairwoman Bovee to the local high school graduates. Pictures will be on display in the Education Center.</p>

In May we had a meeting with the high school, where the parents voiced a need for a culture class. The consensus of the meeting determined that a survey should go out to see if there is an interest in such a program. I was informed by the high school that it would take some time to develop a culture class, so that could not happen this year, so they would like to start a club.
