

## IT Report to TBC 8/30/2021

Here is a summary of IT projects the tech team has been working on:

### Clinic

- a. Greenway health reminders for GPRA & SDPI data have been installed and each provider will be trained to change these reminders in the software to be able to use the latest changes for reporting.
- b. Intergy Direct Messaging from Intergy to clinic patients is still in the training phase and was postponed due to local events
- c. A fail-over internet system is being researched and will be purchased once all options have been explored. The best system would be a new circuit provided by a separate provider designed to cut over when needed if existing circuits fail. Portable dishes antennas are only capable of limited access so should only be used in limited access points.

### Tribal Administration

- a. 7 new 4 megapixel cameras have been purchased and are being installed in our lower-res camera system to provide improved surveillance. They will be mounted in selected areas once we schedule with Public Works for installation. Cameras for the upper-res are still being quoted and an informational packet will be distributed to the TBC members with a budgetary estimate including details for your further consideration.
- b. The NuPoint Mitel Voice Mail server has been ordered from Frontier and we will schedule installation as soon as configuration is complete.
- c. 45 Boxes of documents from NRD have been scanned and archived. An encrypted drive will be delivered by mail with the completion of all these documents. Other considerations for document storage and scanning can use the remainder of the 25 boxes that are still available from Pacific Records Management contract established last year with Covid funds.
