

IT Report to the TBC 04/01/18

1. All connections to the old original network cables have been replaced with new gigabit cables and patch panels. New switches installed during this project provide a new clean local area network operating at much faster speeds than previous. Techs still need to tidy up the network closets by removing those old cables under the buildings and in the rooms.
