ITEM:	CURRENT ACTIVITY
AIEC- (Education Grant)	<p>We finished up our summer program on August 10, 2021. The students had fun with going to the pool, Stewart Museum, trampoline park, Burney Falls and Lassen Volcanic National Park, just to name a few places.</p> <p>We are currently accepting applications for the Education Center for the 2021 – 2022 school year.</p> <p>The school year is at an end, and we have been busy providing incentives to our students enrolled in the center programs who completed their grade level with success.</p> <p>We are accepting applications to the summer program and are ready for the kids beginning June 14th. We have many fun adventures planned and are looking forward to it.</p> <p>Amy was able to participate in the Diploma Gold graduation ceremony, where 2 of our tribal members, 1 tribal family member and a prior student of the Education Center graduated.</p>
JOM	<p>On August 11, 2021, we had the backpack and school supply drive thru giveaway. We purchased \$3,000, items for the backpack and supply giveaway. We will report on the number of backpacks given away next month.</p> <p>In March, JOM requested a student count for the services provided for the 2020-2021 year. Our count reflected 125 students who potentially received services.</p>
CCDF (Child Care) Certificate Program	<p>In June 2021, we submitted payment for childcare in the amount of \$9,634.27. Pending billing from LCOE for July.</p> <p>CCDF has been holding several meetings over the month regarding the money being dispersed under the Biden Administration. It appears the new funding will come with a high amount of reporting on statistical data and small grants to provide to childcare facilities.</p>
IMLS (Library)	<p>With assistance from the teen workers, the Education Center’s library books were completely inventoried into our online catalog program.</p> <p>We are still working on inventorying the library. The new grant for ILMS has been submitted for the grant year 2021-2022. We look forward to expanding our library resources based on higher demands for social and emotional wellbeing.</p>
Teen Center	<p>We hired Fawn Robinson as the new Teen Youth Advisor. She will be a great asset to our team.</p> <p>We are currently accepting applications for the Teen Center and the Youth Council for 2021 – 2022 school year.</p>

We lost Aaron to NRD, his last day was June 4th. We are currently flying the position to be filled.

We were able to provide gifts to the graduates in collaboration with the Chairwoman Bovee to the local high school graduates. Pictures will be on display in the Education Center.

In May we had a meeting with the high school, where the parents voiced a need for a culture class. The consensus of the meeting determined that a survey should go out to see if there is an interest in such a program. I was informed by the high school that it would take some time to develop a culture class, so that could not happen this year, so they would like to start a club. On June 8, 2021, the high school sent out a survey to the families with students enrolled at Lassen High School to see if there is an interest in developing the club.
