



Brownfield Reuse Survey

The following questions will help to assess the SIR communities needs and meet the desires of all community members through creative and flexible redevelopment strategies.

- 1. From the following redevelopment options, please check your preferred reuse option:
 - **Cultural Uses:** Roundhouse, sweat lodge, cultural community garden, interpreted cultural garden.
 - Green Space: Agriculture, wildlife pollinating farm, sports fields and facilities, open space and other recreational activities. These spaces also provide wildlife habitat and nature conservation opportunities.
 - Residential: Multi-family homes, apartments and condos, single-family homes, and other residential purposes, such as senior housing.
 - Industrial: Storage and distribution facilities, renewable energy production (solar).
 - Mixed Use: Combination of two or more reuses for example (roundhouse and cultural community garden, etc.)

- 3. What are some additional redevelopment uses (not listed) that you would like to see?
